1. You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying the Parish Office. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that St Johns reclaims on your donation in the appropriate tax year (currently 25p for every £1 you give)
2. If you pay tax at a higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
3. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay income tax/capital gains tax equal to the tax that St John’s reclaims, you can cancel your declaration
3. Please notify us of any change in your name and address
4. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief then contact your local tax office
