




**Signs Of Heaven** (workshop to explore use of BSL in worship). Saturday 18 November from 10am - 12pm in church.

Clare, Sam, Joel and family would like to thank everyone who gave so generously to Simon's funeral collection. After discussions with family and PCC they would like to announce what they intend to do in Simon's Memory. An amazing total of £5,691.83 was donated. Firstly £3,000.00 will be placed in a new overseas mission fund in Burscough Outreach trust for young people to access, to help them fund travel for mission work, Simon believed strongly in mission and stretching ones faith and was always so encouraging of the youth. It is hoped that others will donate to this fund in future too to keep it topped up. There are plans for a memorial concert too at Burscough Priory and proceeds from this will also go into the fund.

The remaining money will be used to renovate the choir vestry, creating a quiet, warm reflective space that aims to encourage people to connect with God on their own or as part of a small group, it will be decorated with appropriate artwork and comfy seating.
